### DAY 1 | PARIS > COPENHAGEN



Flight on a regular SAS service to Copenhagen. Arrival in Copenhagen. Independent transfer to the city.

Check-in to your standard double room at the Comwell Portside Dolce by Wyndham or a similar hotel.

Dinner at your leisure. Overnight stay.

### DAY 2 | COPENHAGEN

Breakfast.

Free exploration of the Danish capital.

**Copenhagen** will charm you with the lively and genuine friendliness of the Danish people. There are three castles to discover in the heart of the city : **Christiansborg**, where the Parliament convenes, and Rosenborg and Amalienborg, the royal residences where you can witness the changing of the guard. Explore the **Nyhavn** district with its colorful houses and quaint restaurants. Stroll along **Strøget**, a famous pedestrian street known for its shops beloved by shopping enthusiasts. Other highlights of Copenhagen include Andersen's famous Little Mermaid and Tivoli, the amusement park.

### DAY 3 | COPENHAGEN > OSLO



Breakfast.

Independent transfer to the airport for your SAS flight to Oslo. Arrival in Oslo. Independent transfer to the city. Check-in to your standard double room at the Thon Hotel Munch or a similar hotel.

Lunch at your leisure.

Free time to begin your exploration of the Norwegian capital.

**A modern city immersed in nature**, Oslo is situated at the end of a fjord dotted with small islands. Must-see attractions include Karl Johans Gate (the Norwegian Champs Elysées), the Royal Palace, Frogner Park with sculptures by Gustav Vigeland, the Munch Museum, the Holmenkollen ski jump, and the Bygdøy Peninsula, which features the open-air Folk Museum, the Viking Ship Museum, the Fram Museum, and the Kon-Tiki Museum.

Independent transfer to the airport for your SAS flight to Stockholm.

Arrival in Stockholm. Independent transfer to the city. Check-in to your standard double room at the Scandic Anglais hotel. Lunch at your leisure.

Free time to begin your exploration of the Swedish capital.

- Stockholm Cathedral (Storkyrkan): admire the Gothic architecture and the famous St. George and the Dragon.
- The Vasa Museum: explore this unique museum housing the Vasa, a perfectly preserved 17th-century warship.
- ABBA Museum: enjoy an interactive experience dedicated to the famous Swedish pop group.
- Skansen: visit the world's oldest open-air museum, showcasing historic houses and farms, as well as Nordic animals.
- Djurgården: explore this green island, home to numerous museums and attractions.

#### COMWELL HOTEL PORTSIDE DOLCE BY WYNDHAM COPENHAGEN



Located in Copenhagen, the Comwell Copenhagen Portside Dolce by Wyndham features a fitness center, a garden, a shared lounge, and a restaurant. Guests can exercise in the well-equipped gym and unwind in the 2 saunas. The Anglais Bar on-site,

The price of a train ticket from Copenhagen Airport to Copenhagen Central Station is 36 DKK (€4.80).

The price of a direct fast train ticket from Oslo Airport is 190 NOK (€16.40). The journey takes only 20 minutes and has a frequency of 10 to 20 minutes.

The price of a train ticket from Stockholm Airport to Stockholm Central Station, which takes 18 minutes, is 340 SEK (€30).
