Activities

Stegastein Viewpoint – panoramic fjord views 650mas.



Experience the breathtaking Stegastein viewing platform, providing a panoramic view of the Aurlandsfjord.

Jutting out 30 meters from the mountainside, Stegastein Viewpoint offers an unmatched panorama of the fjord, mountains, and surrounding landscape. This sight is truly awe-inspiring, making it the perfect spot for unforgettable holiday photos. Stegastein is one of the most photographed viewpoints in the region.

Situated along the National Tourist Road, known as "The snow road," running from Aurland to Lærdal, the Stegastein Viewpoint was designed by Todd Saunders and Tommie Wilhelmsen, completing construction in 2006. Don't miss out on this remarkable experience!

Electric Fjord Cruise – where every view is a postcard moment!

Explore nature's beauty with ease!

Cruising through Nærøyfjord, a UNESCO World Heritage site, is a memory-making experience. The electric-powered vessels offer a quiet and eco-friendly journey, giving passengers a unique view through tall panoramic windows.

The walkways outside are safe, with a 1-meter railing, and the ship's layout allows easy movement for everyone. Inside, a kiosk offers light meals and drinks.

Choosing Future of The Fjords means choosing sustainability. The electric power minimizes environmental impact, and a quick 20-minute charge in Gudvangen or Flåm keeps things running smoothly.

Start your journey from Flåm or Gudvangen. From Flåm, sail through Aurlandsfjord to Nærøyfjord and end in Gudvangen. The two-hour trip can be complemented with a shuttle bus return. Alternatively, starting in Gudvangen offers a reverse route with convenient shuttle bus options for the way back.

Come for the view, stay for the snow – The best ski touring opportunities surrounding Flåm & Aurland

Blåskavlen (1.804 masl.)

The highest mountain in Aurland municipality is a great destination for intermediate skiers. And what is better than combining a sports activity with beautiful views? On clear days you will be able to overlook large parts of the fjord and mountain landscape of coastal Norway.

How to get there: From the Aurland accommodations, it is only a 20-minute ride to Kvammadal, where the path to Blåskavlen starts. There, you'll find dedicated parking from where you can start your adventure. We recommend using tour apps from Ut.no or Norgeskart.net for navigating your way, since there is no signage for the trail during the winter.



Prest (1.478 masl.)

A shorter version of the Blåskavlen tour is the tour to Mount Prest. From this mountain top you'll have the most panoramic view over the fjords. It is suggested to choose the route up Vetlabotna and continue from there towards the viewpoint.

How to get there: From the Aurland accommodations, it is only a 20-minute ride to Kvammadal, where the path to Prest starts. There, you'll find dedicated parking from where you can start your adventure. We recommend using tour apps from Ut.no or Norgeskart.net for navigating your way, since there is no signage for the trail during the winter.

Vatnahalsen and Myrdal

Combine your skiing adventure with a trip on the world famous Flåmsbana. Both Flåmsbana summit stations, Vatnahalsen and Myrdal, are great starting points for your ski touring adventure. You can find a variety of tours for all levels.

How to get there: The Flåmsbana Station is located right at the harbour in Flåm and just a couple of meters from our Flåm Station Apartments. If you are staying at one of our Aurland accommodations, it is a 10-minute car or bus ride to the station.

Reinungavatnet lake to Seltuft

If you are a ski touring beginner or haven't been on skies for a while, the trip from Vatnahalsen to Seltuft is a wonderful tour for you. It crosses iced lakes and gives you the full experience of high mountain landscape. This route is accessible in most conditions.

If you look for a longer and more challenging tour in this area, you can make the top tour all the way up Tarven (1704 masl.). This trip stretches for about 14 km and a primary factor of about 748 m.

How to get there: You can get from Flåm to Vatnahalsen by train only. The Flåmsbana Station is located right at the harbour in Flåm and just a couple of meters from our Flåm Station Apartments. If you are staying at one of our Aurland accommodations, it is a 10-minute car or bus ride to the station.

Guided Snowshoe Hike – the perfect winter adventure

Discover the wonders of the Norwegian winter on a guided snowshoe hike above the Stegastein viewpoint in Aurland.

Enjoy amazing views of the Aurlandsfjord and experience the fun of walking with traditional snowshoes. Your guide will share interesting stories about the area's history and local tales passed down through generations.

Stay warm with hot beverages, a typical treat on Norwegian snowshoe hikes. This adventure is perfect for beginners, and no prior experience is needed.

Dress warmly in your own clothes, preferably wool, as it can get pretty chilly in winter. Meet up 20 minutes before the hike at the FjordSafari outdoor reception near the Flåm Railway—this is both the starting and ending point of your snowy adventure.

Get ready for a fun snowshoe hike and enjoy the beauty of the Norwegian winter landscape.
