Adventure mini cruise

6 days / 5 nights

Summer 2026

Provisional itinerary 1: Wednesday to Monday.

Day 1: Mining Heritage and Arctic Nature

Location: Longyearbyen

Summary: Arrival in Longyearbyen and city discovery, light dinner at the hotel restaurant. Overnight at Radisson Blu Polar Hotel or Funken Lodge, depending on your cabin category.

Day 2: Settlements of the Far North

Location: Longyearbyen and Isfjord

Summary: Free morning in Longyearbyen, lunch at the hotel, guided tour of the Svalbard Museum and Camp Barentz. Early evening embarkation on MS Serenissima and sailing through Isfjord, along Arctic wildlife and historic sites.

Day 3: Arctic Wilderness

Location: Magdalena Bay and Northwest

Summary: Exploration of remote Arctic regions, including the alpine landscapes of Magdalena Bay, discovery of former whaling sites and local birdlife. Possible landing depending on weather and ice conditions.

Day 4: In Search of Wildlife

Location: Woodfjord, Liefdefjorden, Møffen and 80° North

Summary: Cruising through the scenery of Woodfjord and Liefdefjorden, looking out for polar bears and other iconic species. If conditions allow, sail beyond the 80th parallel north to reach Møffen Island and its walrus colony.

Day 5: Fjords, Glaciers and Scientific Research

Location: Kongsfjorden and Ny-Ålesund

Summary: Admire the beauty of Kongsfjorden, hike in the tundra, visit the scientific base at Ny-Ålesund. Learn about the Arctic's exploration history and send a postcard from the world's northernmost post office.

Day 6: Journey Home

Location: Longyearbyen

Summary: Disembarkation with transfers between the ship and the town, then to the airport for your return flight. Last chance to explore Longyearbyen and shop for souvenirs.
