Wildlife and glaciers

Unique in its kind, this dog sled on wheels offers an original way to immerse yourself in the landscapes of Svalbard. The route follows Adventdalen Road, surrounded by mountains. With a bit of luck, reindeer will join the adventure. And after the ride, the dogs are waiting for a cuddle session!

Over the millennia, Longyearbreen has eroded the mountain ranges, scattering rocks and gravel to form a vast moraine that changes every year. During this hike, you'll have the chance to search for plant fossils dating back as far as 60 million years.

We now offer an even more sustainable option to explore the fjords of Spitsbergen: our hybrid electric catamaran, MS Bard. Sail through stunning landscapes toward Billefjorden and the Nordenskiöldbreen glacier front and observe whales and the rich birdlife thriving in the area.
