


One-day adventure, Forest Tower & Climbing Park

The Forest Tower (Skovtårnet), standing 45 meters tall, is located in the forest of Gissfeld Castle and offers a unique nature experience on the island of Zealand, where you can discover the forest from completely new perspectives.

Have you ever dreamed of soaring above the treetops? At the largest climbing park in Denmark, located on Zealand, this dream becomes reality. In the heart of a beautiful beech forest, 12 different climbing courses wind through the trees at varying heights and difficulty levels, suitable for both beginners and experienced climbers.



The Forest Tower


Experience a thrilling sensation. Beyond the remarkable architecture of the Forest Tower, admire the nature of southern Zealand and the breathtaking view from its summit, rising above the treetops. Here, in the heart of the Gisselfeld forests, enjoy a unique sensory experience—from your first glimpse of the 45-meter-high tower to the moment you admire the landscape of southern Zealand from its observation deck.

At 45 meters high, the Forest Tower is the highest observation point in Zealand and in all of Scandinavia.

The adventure begins at the old water mill, where you step onto a 3.2-kilometer elevated walkway that winds through the forest, circling trees and crossing streams until the Forest Tower suddenly appears between the branches. The ascent then begins, and with each turn along the twelve spiraling circles leading to the top, you'll notice how the surrounding nature transforms along with the architecture.

Up and up you go, until you reach the center of the observation tower, where the hourglass-shaped structure narrows so closely that you can actually touch three beech trees growing inside the tower itself.

Finally, you arrive at the panoramic platform, 140 meters above sea level, offering stunning views over forests and fields. On a clear day, you can even spot Copenhagen and Malmö, more than 50 kilometers away. A sense of vertigo is almost guaranteed.



The Climbing Park

The climbing park, located on the island of Zealand, is the largest in Denmark, covering 7.5 hectares and featuring 12 climbing courses winding through a beech forest. It offers activities for the whole family.

In the most beautiful treetop adventure park in Zealand, you will find courses focused on adventure and balance, exciting zip lines, and family-friendly routes. High up in the trees, you'll encounter ladders, trapezes, swings, nets, and countless other must-try elements.

Finish your adventure in spectacular fashion with a 500-meter thrilling descent through the forest on Denmark's longest zip line, which completes the red and blue courses.

A visit to the climbing park is an action-packed and entertaining experience for both children and adults—and we can almost guarantee that the whole family will sleep well after a day of adventure in the trees.

An entry ticket to the climbing park gives access to all 12 climbing routes. The maximum allowed weight per participant is 120 kg.





Good to know :

- Activities can be booked separately.
- Excursions can only be booked with a package reservation.
- Please note that all our courses are subject to age and height restrictions. Our children's climbing area is reserved for children aged 3 to 6. To access the other courses, participants must be at least 7 years old and between 110 and 130 cm tall. Our instructors are there to guide you and ensure a safe and enjoyable climbing experience.
